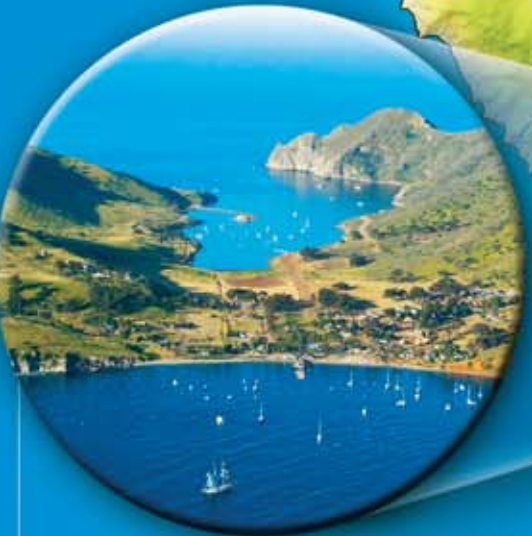

If you have about: **TWO HOURS**

- GARDEN:** Trolley or Wildlands Express to the Nature Center, walk the Garden.
- HIKE:** Trolley or Wildlands Express to Garden, and do the Garden to Sky Hike for best Island views!
- BIKE:** Bike or Segway® to the Nature Center at Avalon Canyon and Garden and breathe it in!

If you have about: **A HALF DAY**

- TOUR:** Take a custom Jeep® Eco Tour to the wildlands, including places like the Airport, Little Harbor, and more!
- AIRPORT:** Take Wildlands Express to Airport in the Sky, walk the Soapstone Trail, and have lunch at DC-3 Gifts and Grill.
- GARDEN/MUSEUM:** Trolley or Wildlands Express to Garden, and do the Garden to Sky Hike for great views. In town, walk, bike or Segway® to the Museum for some culture!
